REGULATIONS

THE 3RD INTERNATIONAL SKORPION TOURNAMENT CUP UNDER THE PATRONAGE OF THE HONORARY PRESIDENT OF THE Z.O.Z.B, TADEUSZ PLISKO, 2012.

- 1) The aim of the competition is to promote the ability of the youngest competitors in preparation for 'main events'.
- 2) The organizer of the competition is Scorpion Boxing Club (BKS), Szczecin.
- 3) The competition has three age categories:
 - a) Youths born between 1998 and 1999 who weigh from 37kg to 76 kg+
 - b) Cadets born between 1996 and 1997. The applicable weight categories in this age-group are: 42 kg, 44kg, 46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg, 80 kg
 - c) Juniors born between 1994 and 1995. The applicable weight categories in this age-group are: 52kg, 56kg, 60kg, 69kg, 75kg, 81kg, 91kg
- 4) Only competitors who have completed a medical examination (and have written proof of this) have the right to take part on the competition.
- 5) The competition will be held over a four-day tournament period at the sports hall on ul. Wąskej 16, Szczecin. It will take place on: 01/28/2012, 02/11/2012, 03/10/2012 & 04/28/2012, for the tournament final.
- 6) Programme schedule:
 - 9.00-10.30 - weighing in and medical examination
 - 10.45-11.30 - technical conference and competition draw
 - 12.30 onwards – the competition begins (boxing matches)

- 7) Fighting opponents are chosen by drawing lots. If an odd number of competitors occur in a neighbouring weight division, an official has the right to move the competitor with the least amount of boxing experience to the lower the weight division. The Club organizing the draw may grant its own club member competitor no.1. The competitors from one club will be dispersed in the draw. All competitors must be given medical permission to fight after consulting a physician. Withdrawal of a competitor after lots have been drawn will result in forfeiting points.

8) Scoring

- A victory is awarded with three points.
 - A draw is awarded two points.
 - A defeat is awarded one point.
 - A 'walkover' victory is awarded three points
 - A 'thrown' fight is not awarded any points.
 - The lack of an opponent is awarded one point.
 - Match winners are the players in each age category who earn the highest number of points.
 - In cases where an equal number of points are scored by more than one competitor, the following considerations will be taken in this order: the result of the final boxing match, the number of matches, the number of draws and a which point in the competition and the number of results:3:0 and 2:1

- 9) Protective equipment for participating club members. Competitors will use 10-ounce (certified by AIBA) gloves: (**ADIDAS, FBT PRO, TOPTEN, WESING, STING**)

Youths fight 3 rounds of 1.5minutes
Cadets fight 3 rounds of 2 minutes
Juniors fight 3 rounds of 3minutes

10) Prizes

All competitors at each age and weight division admitted to the competition will receive a medal and diploma. Individual prizes may be awarded additionally.

- a) Youths and Cadets: 1st - 5th place will receive trophies donated by BKS Scorpion, Szczecin.
Junior: 1st - 3rd places receive trophies donated by BKS Scorpion, Szczecin.
- b) Honorary Cup (ZOZB) president, Tadeusz Plisko, will decide on the best competitor of the entire tournament from all three age groups.
- c) The club that scores the most points over all three age groups will receive the Skorpion Cup funded by BKS Szczecin.
